SUBJECT: Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Dear Mr Aljabiry:

Enclosed is the documentation for Administrative Modification #7 to the 2009 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications. State approval is required, however Federal approval is not required.

FTIP Modification #7 amends the following projects in the 2009 FTIP:

- (1) For Lodi Ave Project increase ARRA TE amount by \$59,799 and decrease ARRA RSTP amount by \$59,799 in FY 08/09 Construction Phase.
- (2) Changes Fund types to be consistent with apportionments established by ABX3 20, please see attachment 1 for additional information.
- (3) Increase local share of funds for City of Escalon FTA Section 5311 Operating Assistance Project from \$32,650 to \$48,250 in FY 08/09 Construction Phase.
- (4) Revise scope of Bessie Ave Reconstruction Current Scope - Reconstruction between 11th street and Grant line Rd. Revised Scope – Reconstruction Between 11th street and Carlton Ave, total reduction 2300 feet.
- (5) Adding additional phase information to the backup listing to clarify all projects are programmed for construction phase in all FFY, Please see attachment 2.
