This adaptation implementation plan will expand and compliment previous efforts to go beyond identification of exposure to climate stressors to develop a comprehensive adaptation pathway that includes feasible short-, medium-, and long-term strategies to address identified climate vulnerabilities on the state highway routes and assets within the Sacramento- San Joaquin delta region.
