

SJVAPCD's Grants & Incentives: E-Mobility

Purpose of the Program

To expand telecommunication and electronic services that replace vehicle travel to public sites for conferencing, document transactions, general information, work functions, school instruction and related applications. More specifically, to encourage the development of:

- Distance learning facilities
- Teleconference systems
- E-court technology
- Telecommute center equipment
- E-government technology
- Other

Eligible E-Mobility Projects

The project must demonstrate reduced VMT by public, and function to replace vehicle travel by residents seeking public or educational services. It should demonstrate reductions with supportive documentation (i.e. administrative records, production reports, surveys, customer/client counts, data registrations, etc)

Must describe current number and purpose of vehicle travel to the public agency or school site and establish average travel distance and the project will reduce the VMT to these sites.

Potential Funding

Teleconference Systems	Up to \$150,000
E – Government Technology	Up to \$150,000
E – Court Technology	Up to \$150,000
Telecommute Centers	Up to \$150,000
Distance Learning Facility	Up to \$150,000
Other	Up to \$150,000

Other Program Highlights

- Annual self-monitoring required for two years from the initiation of the project.
- Incentive amounts based on ARB calculation methodologies for emissions reduction. Cost effectiveness value determines funding. Minimizing cost per pound is highly recommended.
- Funds are first-come, first-serve.
- Individual applications restricted to one project category. However, separate applications may be submitted for additional project categories.
- Additional funding sources are not required. Other co-funding encouraged (State / Federal)
- Funds may not be used for projects that would have otherwise proceeded.
- May not use the elimination of an existing project/program to justify e-mobility project.
- Must provide verification of all funding sources that have been solicited to fund a project or program.
- May not fund administrative or operational costs.
- SJVAPCD receives the emission reductions credits.
