February 2, 2023 SMC Steering Committee Community Engagement Team Updates

Update 1. Event Planning

We are finalizing details for participating, hosting, and co-hosting several events in the coming months.

- **March Launch Event.** We are finalizing details for the launch event that will promote the SMC projects including electric bikes, carshare and incentive programs. The event will include the chance to test-ride bikes, sign up for the MioCar and Vamos apps, learn about the incentive program and meet other CBO's working on environmental justice projects in Stockton.
 - Tentative Location: University of the Pacific
 - Tentative Date: March 25
- **TCC-SMC Joint Annual Summit.** We are partnering with the Transformative Climate Communities (TCC) team to host an Annual Summit to bring the project teams together to share milestones and successes, and discuss lessons learned and coordinate collaboration.
 - Location: TBD
 - Tentative Date: Mid-to-Late April
- **Peer-to-Peer Event.** The event will launch a peer-to-peer learning network to share community engagement best practices between SMC, TCC, the AB617 air quality working group, and Regional Climate Collaborative project team.
 - Tentative date: Q2
- **Focus Groups.** The team is in the process of scheduling with the Environmental Justice Coalition for Water and rescheduling with the Public Health Advocates Clergy Network Group.
 - Amelia Ann Adams Whole Life Center (1/24): 7 community members attended and provided feedback on South Stockton sites and shared transportation challenges.
- **Other Events.** The team will continue to explore opportunities to attend and table at community events to share out project information and display the bikes and cars (when possible).

Update 2. Mini-Grantee Round 2 Outreach

In January the public engagement team started the second round of outreach to potential mini-grantees and reconnecting with organizations where MOUs are in progress (listed below). CARSHARE UPDATES

Vehicle procurement has made major progress. The carshare team has successfully procured eight out of thirty electric vehicles (EVs). More EVs are currently pending for purchase. The carsharing program was first launched in August 2022 at the Housing Authority of the County of San Joaquin's (HACSJ) Conway Homes with three EVs. A second station was added in November 2022 at HACSJ's Grand Canal office with one EV thus far. Two more EVs are expected to be added to Grand Canal soon. The carshare team is working to formalize its partnerships with the University of the Pacific, the City of Stockton, and potentially other new site hosts to launch more carshare stations in Stockton.

Recently, there has been a recall of the 2019 Chevy Bolts. This recall pertains to two EVs that have not been deployed yet. Links for recalls are below:
