SCS Consistency Checklist Form

The SCS Consistency Checklist consists of both a project description section and questionnaire. To complete the form:

- 1) Provide a brief description of the overall project
- 2) Indicate whether the proposed project meets the SCS policy goal using the “Yes” or “No” check boxes
- 3) If the project meets the indicated policy goal, check all SCS strategies that apply in the project’s implementation of the policy goal or indicate other
- 4) Describe how the project meets the goal in narrative form
- 5) Base all responses on anticipated project benefits
- 6) Attach relevant project materials (funding applications, artist renderings, etc.)
